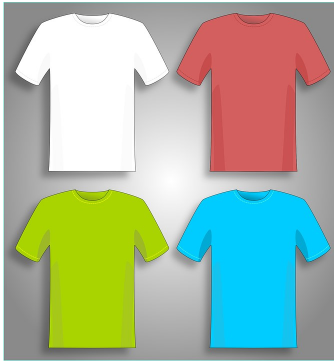


Ice cream Fridays
