Ignis drumming performance

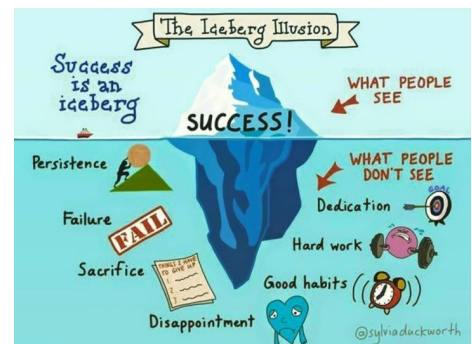
