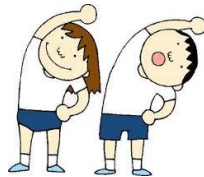

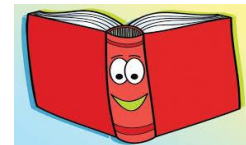

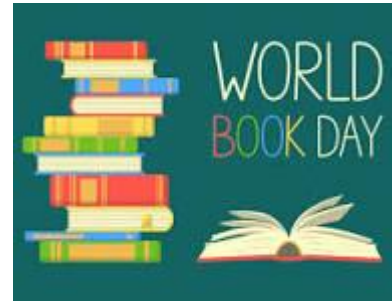
School Fundraising Account
