

# Cosgrove Village Primary School - Class 3

## Mathematics

The children will learn about the following areas over the summer term:

- Timetables
- Telling the time
- Geometry (properties of shape and position and movement of shape)
- Algebra
- Statistics

## Music

The children will be participating in samba drumming sessions through NMPAT.

## Geography.

Map/atlas work. Identifying places in the UK and countries around the world.  
Use 4 figure grid references.  
Understand OS map symbols including contours.  
Use scales to show accurate distances on maps.

## History

Discovering where The Tudors fit into British history.  
Finding out about the Tudors and significant figures during this time.  
Comparing the Tudor explorers Magellan and Drake.

## English – Reading, Writing, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

Grammar and Reading focused revision.

Historical narrative

Discovering who William Shakespeare was and studying 'Macbeth'. The children will learn about playscripts and use descriptive writing, including scene setting, for story writing.

## Science

### Earth and Space

Describe movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system  
Describe movement of the Moon relative to the Earth  
Understand the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies  
Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

### Animals Including Humans

Identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood  
Recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function  
Describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.
